Wilderness Unlimited (WU) has offered us this spectacular hunt on their property. We will be hunting from three-person blinds. Two women will hunt with a guide and a dog. We have all of the equipment - guns, ammo, waders, and boots. This is a unique opportunity to learn to duck hunt in one of the most waterfowl populated areas of the central valley.

There is nothing quite like being in a duck blind as the world around you wakes up and starts to move. Just as the sun starts to rise you'll become aware of the beauty all around you. The sights and sounds are truly unique to this experience.



We will arrive at the club house on Friday for dinner. It's a time to get to know each other and our guides. We will be

outfitted with our equipment and discuss safety practices, laws and regulations, hunter ethics, waterfowl identification and the schedule for the following day.

Overnight accommodations are available at the WU RV park. If you prefer to bring your own RV, there is room to park. Or, if you prefer to go to a hotel in Williams, your guide can pick you up there. You will want to sign up early for this hunt. There are only 10 spaces available.
